Issues with Parking

Unfortunately, the issue of parking near the school gates during drop-off and pick-up times is, once again, becoming an increasing concern.



Safety First: The safety of our children is our top priority. We have noticed an increase in dangerous parking practices that pose a risk to our students as they arrive at and leave school. Please ensure you are parking safely and not blocking the school gates or pedestrian pathways, and please avoid parking on the zig-zagged lines at all times.

Considerate Parking: We also ask that you be mindful of our neighbours. Inconsiderate parking can cause inconvenience and frustration for those living nearby. Let's work together to maintain a positive relationship with our community by parking considerately and respecting their driveways and access points.

What You Can Do:

- Avoid double parking: This can create hazardous conditions for children crossing the road.
- Be patient: Allow extra time for drop-off and pick-up to avoid rushing and potentially unsafe manoeuvres.
