The doll was created with help from the autistic community, so more people can see themselves reflected in their toys.



Things you could talk about at home:

WONDER (Looking out at the world)

- When you look at toys or characters that show many kinds of people, what do you notice or wonder about God's diverse world and the people He has created?

REFLECT (Looking inwards at ourselves)

- How do you feel when you see a toy or character that is like you, and what might this help you notice about how God knows, loves, and values you?

DO (Responding through actions and choices)

- What could we do to help others feel included, respected, and loved - especially if they feel different or left out - so that our actions show Jesus' teaching to care for our neighbours?

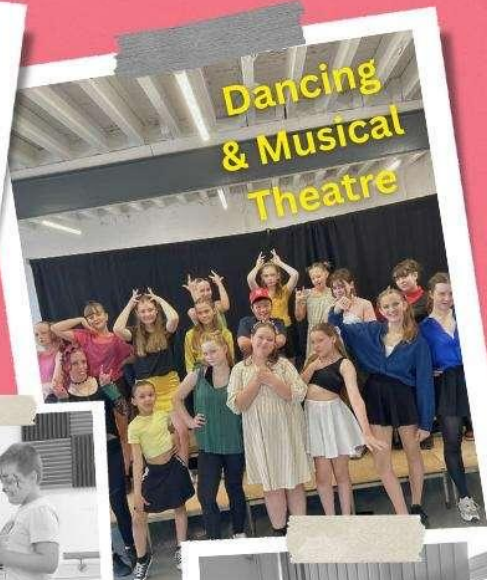
