Collective Worship Take Home

In Collective Worship this week, we have been thinking about how NASA is preparing to send a powerful new telescope into space to explore some of the universe's biggest mysteries. The Nancy Grace Roman Space Telescope will search large areas of the sky for distant planets and study galaxies, dark matter and dark energy. Scientists hope it will help us learn how the universe has changed and why it is growing faster.

Things you could talk about at home:

WONDER (Looking out at the world)

- What question about God's world or the universe would you most like to ask?

REFLECT (Looking inwards at ourselves)

- Can you remember a time when asking a thoughtful question helped you discover something new or understand something better?

DO (Responding through actions and choices)

- What can you do this week to learn more about God's world and deepen your sense of wonder?
